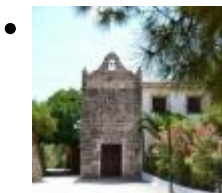


Beer Festivity ^[11]

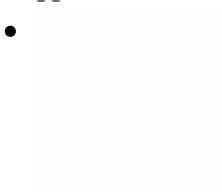


Bonfires of San Juan ^[12]

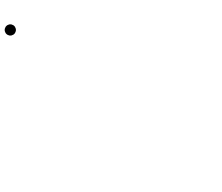

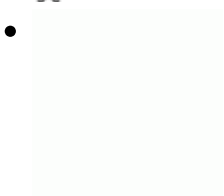


Bous a la Mar ^[16]

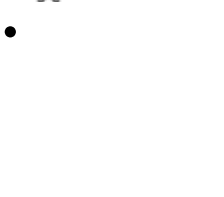


Cabalgata de los Reyes Magos ^[17]
