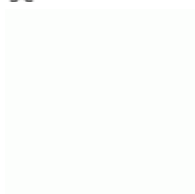


Alcoy's Town Hall ^[9]

Muslims built this tower for vigilance and defence purposes. Nowadays only half of the destroyed tower remains.

Coastal vigilance was achieved from strategically placed towers such as the Ambolo tower, a very voluminous watchtower with a cylindrical body built on top of the headland.

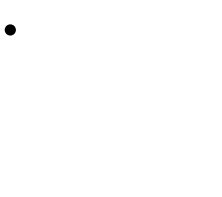


Arraval [25]

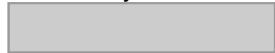
